Operation Christmas Shoebox

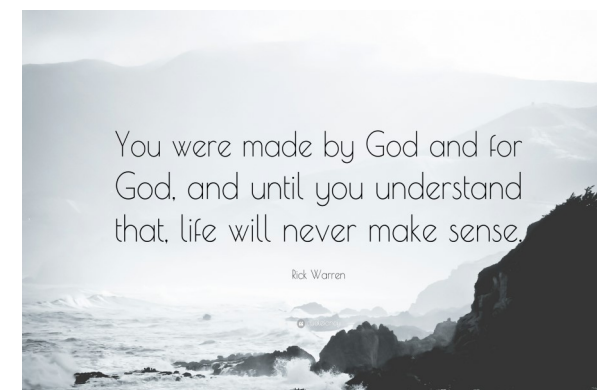
